

The Public Works Department is responsible for street maintenance, park maintenance, water distribution system, wastewater system, and storm sewer.

The City of Mapleton provides approximately 45 million gallons of water per year to the citizens of Mapleton, which is an average of approximately 125,000 gallons/day. Ground water sources provide 100% of our water from 2 wells 400 feet deep and are highly regulated and tested by the City Water Department and the

The City of Mapleton handles approximately 350,000 gallons/day of wastewater generated by the residents and businesses of Mapleton.
